Missionary Health Care



Here are some important details about Missionary Health Care:

The cost of providing insurance for Nazarene missionaries is quite high. In fact, the cost for health insurance alone for a year is approximately \$1.9 million, and the costs continue to rise. Yet the Church of the Nazarene wants its missionaries to be able to serve and not worry about where they will scrape up the cost of the next premium.

Nazarene Missions International has helped subsidize some of these funds since as early as 1919. Through your giving to the Memorial Roll, Distinguished Service Award, Gifts from the Heart, and Missionary Health Care plate offerings, you helped offset approximately 23 percent of those insurance costs. Thank you!


The remaining 77 percent of the insurance costs is provided by the World Evangelism Fund. So two important facts to remember are:

- The more money that comes in for Missionary Health Care, the more money from World Evangelism Fund can be used specifically for evangelism.
- Giving to World Evangelism Fund affects many aspects of missions in the Church of the Nazarene.

MESSAGE FROM DS BOB SKINNER

Dear All...this is for you and your circles of influence. Starting May 1st we are asking the Rocky Mountain District Family to pray each day for the upcoming District "Family Reunion" and District Assembly June 11-16 at Abba's Haven, about an hour north of Billings. Our over-arching prayer is for the Holy Spirit of God to be poured out on the RMD, to freely move among us, that HIS will be done in making us One as He is One!

Dr. Dennis Kinlaw in his book, Prayer, Bearing the World as Jesus Did (pg. 91-93), says some amazing things about gathering together!

"I invite you to consider the need for a specific type of prayer: the prayer for revival, inviting Christ to come and dwell anew within his people.

If Salvation is the personal presence of the Lord Jesus, then revival is needed again and again because all personal relationships need times of refreshing.

In Old Testament times, God commanded that all Jews should gather three times a year in the city of Jerusalem for specific festivals.

They had come together because God called them together.

Why did God say his people should travel great distances at great personal sacrifice to come together in this way? Because God can do things for us when we are together that he cannot do when we remain separate and alone. A group of people corporately worshiping God have a spiritual potential that cannot be found in a single person's worship. Groups have a greater potential for transformation, as well as greater accountability for their actions.

"Something holy takes place when a group of people come together to seek God."

In preparation of our hearts and minds for this District Camp and Assembly we would like to suggest some areas of prayer for each day of May and then culminate with a time for all who are able to join in a prayer walk around the camp ground itself on Saturday June 1st.

For families with kiddos, it might be helpful to take the first letter of each day and pray with them for details that also begin with that letter!! Here are some ideas... let them add their own creative thoughts, too! :)

In July 2014, Bill Kwon began serving as the Myanmar country coordinator for the Southeast Asia field. He served as the District Superintendent of the Myanmar District from 2015–2019.

Bill Kwon was elected as the 6th chancellor of Southeast Asia Nazarene Bible College (SEANBC) in August 2015. In 2018, SEANBC has surpassed that goal by simultaneously growing and multiplying having grown to 792 students studying in 41 learning centers in mainland Southeast Asia.

Nazarene Theological Seminary and helps with
regional education development. Rhonda serves as the
Member Care (Missionary Care) and Mission
Mobilization Coordinator for the
Philippines/Micronesia Field. They reside on the APNTS
campus in Manila, Philippines.

The Ackermans were Global Missionaries for the Church of the Nazarene from 1999 to 2008. They spent over seven years at APNTS, where David was Professor of New Testament and Rhonda was parttime campus nurse and involved in various ministries. They also served at Nazarene Theological College in Australia, where David was Lecturer in Bible and Rhonda assisted in campus ministries. They have been involved in pastoral ministry in Idaho, Wyoming, Australia, Colorado, and most recently in Guam.

Rhonda earned a Bachelor of Arts in Compassionate
Ministries in 1989 from Northwest Nazarene University
and a Bachelor of Science in Nursing in 1992 from
Rockhurst University and Research College of Nursing.
She is a Registered Nurse. Her passion is to come
alongside people and help them grow in the Lord. She
has become a certified Strengths Advisor through the
Church of the Nazarene and is using this in leadership
development. Both Rhonda and David are ordained
elders in the Church of the Nazarene.
